

## 2006-2007 Annual Report

This past year, the Literacy Council served 221 adults in our Adult Basic Education and English as a Second Language programs. We believe that our services are making a difference in many lives across Buncombe County. Take a look at our 2006-2007 statistics.

- **78 students improved at least one educational level**
- **18 entered employment**
- **9 students received a promotion at work**
- **10 became U.S. citizens**
- **68 reported becoming more involved in their children's educational activities**
- **12 students obtained a driver's license**
- **132 improved reading skills**

Additionally, 203 volunteers provided 13,684 hours of instruction to our students! That's a value of \$256,848 as determined by the Independent Sector.
